Sir,

As Central Government by notification, constituted a Commission, to be known as the National Commission for Homoeopathy, to exercise the powers conferred upon, and to perform the functions assigned to it, as per NCH Act 2020 and its relevant regulations.

As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform you that all the relevant documents submitted by your college in Part-1 proforma were examined by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has observed following shortfalls.

- 1. **College laboratories:** In pharmacy department -glass apparatus for filtration with vacuum is 01 against 02.
- 2. Teaching faculty:-
- a) Fulltime:- There are deficiencies of higher faculty in Pathology and Repertory departments. Although the college is meeting the requirement of 28 faculty of MSR 2013 but discrepancies found in following faculties:-
- Dr K Kiran Kumar (Professor, Pathology)-Not eligible as Professor, Pathology as previous experience from 17-08-07 to 25-11-17 in physiology; joined as Professor Pathology on 11-12-18.
- Dr K. Samuel Sunil K (Professor, Practice of Medicine)-Not eligible as Professor Practice of Medicine as previous experience from 1984 to 26-03-21 in Surgery & Physiology; changed department from 27-03-21 as Professor Practice of Medicine
- Dr Sucharitha Amsole (Reader, Repertory) Promotion as reader (25/05/2019) is not justified because experience of 4 years as Lecturer (from 01/02/2014 to 30/11/2015) is not fulfilled as per MSR 2013.
- b) Guest faculty:-The College has provided 12 Guest Faculties but only 08 are eligible.
- 3. Miscellaneous:-
- Acquittance of 31 staff provided but month is not mentioned without stamp.
- Form- 16 of 08 staff provided but not from traces portal.
- 4. **Website**:-http://www..hamsahomeopathy.org is functional but staff and OPD/IPD is not updated as checked on date: 15/11/2022.

After considering the provisions of NCH Act,2020 and its relevant regulations Conditional Permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board is issued to Shreeyan Ishaan Educational Society, Hamsa Homoeopathy Medical College, Hospital and Research Centre, Sy. No. 617, 618, Opp. ZPHS High School, Ksheerasagar, Mulugu, Siddipet, Telangana 502279 for 100 Seats for UG 1st BHMS Course during the academic year 2022-2023

All admissions in Under Graduate course shall be through NEET only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India Quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted there under.

The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules.

The college has to comply with the full requirements as per NCH Act,2020 for conducting the course. All deficiencies observed, specially deficiencies regarding higher faculty should be rectified within 30 days' time from issue of this permission letter. Compliance report shall be submitted by the college to Medical Assessment and Rating Board accordingly. Subsequently, the Board shall verify the compliance well in time and may conduct Online/Physical inspection for verification of compliance.
